#### Comics and Pictograms

A comic is a story with images, divided into scenes. The words spoken by the characters appear in speech bubbles. Onomatopoeia is used to express sounds.




A pictogram is a symbol or image that represents a word or idea. We are all familiar with the pictogram "No Smoking" posted in public buildings and the signs "No Diving" painted in pools.



## Symmetry and Asymmetry

An image is symmetrical if it can be divided into two identical parts. Otherwise, the image is asymmetrical.





### Artistic Signatures and Logos

Artworks often bear the artist's signature, which is their special way of writing their name, or their logo, which is a symbol that represents them.





#### Collage and Photomontage

To create a collage, we compose a creation by pasting various pieces and fragments of other drawings or photographs onto a surface or base. To perform a photomontage, we combine fragments of photographs to create a new image.





#### Dadaism

"Dada" means nothing. Dadaists create spontaneous Art that often makes no sense .
