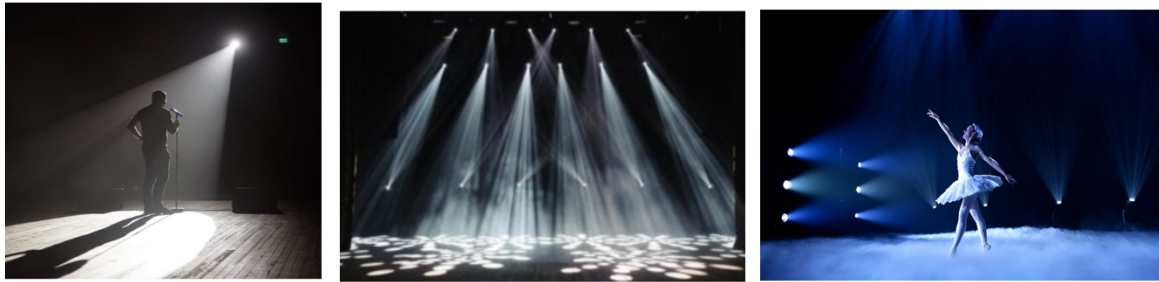


Body Language in Theater and Dance

Body language in theater and dance involves communication through movement and gesture. It is a form of non-verbal language.

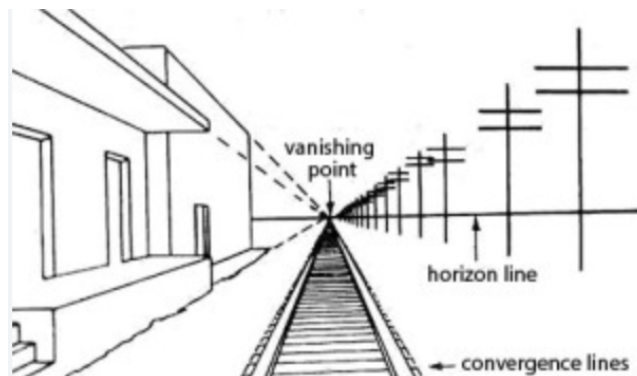
Theater Lighting
